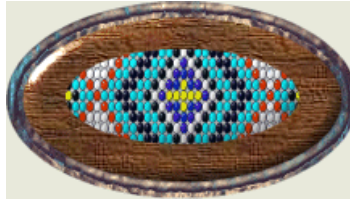

ONLY TWO MONTHS UNTIL THE 2009 REUNION

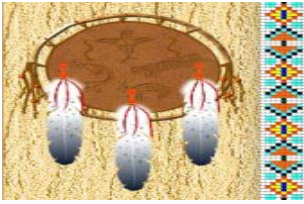
It is time to start thinking about attending the Annual Fall Reunion of Old Kia Kima.

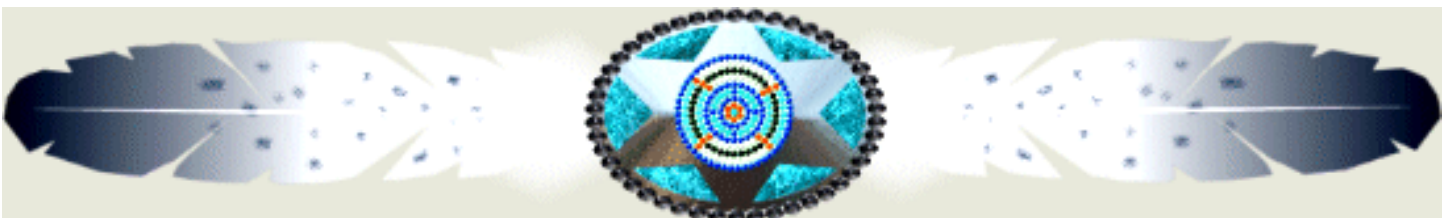
